

#### **MAYOR'S UPDATE:**

As the crisp fall air returns to Mount Clemens and the leaves start to turn, it's a perfect time to reflect on the progress we've made together and the exciting work still ahead. I'm proud to share several key updates that reflect our commitment to investing in the future of our community.

#### **Downtown Revitalization Project Update**

Our Downtown Revitalization Project continues to move

forward with purpose and energy. I'm happy to share that the hardscape portion of the project—including sidewalks, pavers, curbs, and street features—is on track for completion by **November 1, 2025**. While construction can be inconvenient at times, I want to thank our residents and business owners for their patience and support. The result will be a more walkable, vibrant, and welcoming downtown district—one that honors our city's rich history while positioning us for new growth. I encourage everyone to keep shopping local and dining downtown throughout the construction season. Every visit supports the heartbeat of our community.

#### **Great Lakes Water Authority Connection Project Update**

As the design of the Great Lakes Water Authority connection wrapped up this summer, our engineering team submitted the plans to EGLE for approval. Construction is scheduled to begin late summer/early fall 2025.

#### Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Budget Passed

I'm pleased to announce that the City Commission has officially passed the fiscal year 2025–2026 budget. This balanced and strategic plan reflects our city's values: maintaining essential services, investing in infrastructure, and making smart financial decisions for the long term. Once again, we've prioritized road repairs with a \$1.5 million investment in local streets, including a full reconstruction of Grand Avenue that will be wrapping up this fall. We're also dedicating resources to public safety, parks, and modernizing our city services.

#### Oakland University Building Purchase

In another exciting development, the City of Mount Clemens has purchased the former Oakland University satellite campus building located at 20 South Main Street. This acquisition is a bold step forward for our city. The building will be renovated to serve as the future home of City Hall and our Fire Department, giving both departments upgraded space in a central location. Even more exciting—the move will open up the riverfront property currently housing City Hall and the Fire Department for future development.

#### **HOLIDAY REFUSE CALENDAR**

#### Labor Day – Monday, September 1, 2025

There will be NO garbage pickup on Monday, September 1st. Pickup will run one day behind schedule for the entire week beginning Monday, September 1st, through Friday, September 5th. Regular garbage pickup will resume on Monday, September 8, 2025.

#### Columbus Day – Monday, October 13, 2025

Garbage pickup will run on schedule during the entire month of October.

#### Veteran's Day – Tuesday, November 11, 2025

Garbage pickup will run on schedule during Veteran's Day week - November 10th through November 14th.

#### Thanksgiving Day – Thursday, November 27, 2025

There will be NO garbage pickup on Thursday, November 27th. Thursday's garbage will be picked up on Friday, November 28th and Friday's garbage will be picked up on Saturday, November 29th. Garbage pickup for Monday, November 24th, Tuesday, November 25th, and Wednesday, November 26th will be **on schedule**.

#### COMPOST/LEAF PICKUP SEASON ENDS DECEMBER 5TH

The City of Mount Clemens will again be enforcing its leaf pick up policy this fall. RAKING AND BLOWING LEAVES INTO THE STREET IN THE CITY OF MOUNT CLEMENS IS PROHIBITED. All leaves that do not fall into the street from the trees **MUST** be placed in 30-gallon brown waste bags or 25- to 35-gallon refuse containers.

A City contracted yard waste collection truck will operate through December 5, 2025 only. This truck will pick up only properly contained and bundled yard waste. **YARD WASTE IN PLASTIC BAGS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP**. Brush piles and yard waste must be placed in 30-gallon brown waste bags or 25- to 35-gallon refuse containers marked "COMPOST" or "YARD WASTE" that weigh 50 pounds or less. Brush must be cut into four-foot lengths and tied in bundles. Bundles must not weigh more than 50 pounds or be over 18 inches in diameter. Large logs and branches over 3 inches in diameter, as well as stumps or roots, will not be picked up for collection.

Place all yard waste at curbside no earlier than 6 p.m. the day before your scheduled pick up day and **NO LATER THAN 7:00 A.M.** of your scheduled pick up day.

**ABSOLUTELY NO RAKING OR BLOWING LEAVES INTO THE STREET. IF YOU HAVE A LANDSCAPING COMPANY, PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT THEY ARE AWARE OF THIS POLICY.** Please remember that following city policy will not only be appreciated by the City of Mount Clemens, but also by your neighbor who has been taking the time to bag their leaves.

The City will schedule a clean-up crew to come down every street at least twice during this season to pick up the leaves that have fallen from the trees. The City will not release a schedule due to the uncertain weather conditions during the fall season.

## MOUNT CLEMENS FIRE DEPARTMENT

#### A MESSAGE FROM FIRE CHIEF REYNOLDS

Good day Mount Clemens,

As fall approaches and the heating of your home starts to become necessary, I would like to provide you with some tips to keep your family safe. I want to talk to you about something you cannot see, you cannot smell, and you cannot taste; carbon monoxide (CO), aka the silent killer. Did you know that the colorless and odorless gas known as carbon monoxide is created in all gas appliances and gas operating equipment, such as furnaces, water heaters, gas clothes dryers, gas ovens, generators, and even automobile exhaust? Although it is a "normal" by-product of combustion, it can be deadly if not properly vented or if allowed to accumulate in the home. Your gas appliances are designed to vent this gas to the outside of your home, and often there is no problem. To be sure your family is safe, you must protect your home with a carbon monoxide detector. A carbon monoxide detector serves as a "silent sentry", ever monitoring for an accumulation of the lethal gas. The MCFD recommends that each home have at least one CO detector and that it is positioned where it would best warn sleeping occupants - near the bedrooms! CO detectors are highly reliable and have come down significantly in price. They are available at any hardware or general merchandise store.



- CO alarms should be installed in a central location outside each sleeping area and on every level of the home and in other
  locations where required by applicable laws, codes or standards. For the best protection, interconnect all CO alarms
  throughout the home. When one sounds, they all sound.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for placement and mounting height.
- Choose a CO alarm that is listed by a qualified testing laboratory.
- Test CO alarms at least once a month; replace them according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- If the audible trouble signal sounds, check for low batteries. If the battery is low, replace it. If it still sounds, call the fire department.
- If the CO alarm sounds, immediately move to a fresh air location outdoors or by an open window or door. Make sure everyone inside the home is accounted for. Call for help from a fresh air location and stay there until emergency personnel declare that it is safe to re-enter the home.
- If you need to warm a vehicle, remove it from the garage immediately after starting it. Do not run a vehicle or other fueled engine or motor indoors, even if garage doors are open. Make sure the exhaust pipe of a running vehicle is not covered with snow.
- During and after a snowstorm, make sure vents for the dryer, furnace, stove, and fireplace are clear of snow build-up.
- A generator should be used ONLY in a well-ventilated location outdoors away from windows, doors, and vent openings.
- Gas or charcoal grills can produce CO—only use outside.

The Mount Clemens Fire Department hopes that you follow these important safety tips and wants to remind you that smoke detectors are available for free (to Mount Clemens residents) at the fire station located at 2 Dickinson Street.




Honoring Mt. Clemens' legacy as "Bath City," once famous for its mineral baths, the building now houses tenants focused on physical and mental well-being.





Designed to meet people where they are, the program helps families create safe, stable, and nurturing home environments. Services include case management, basic needs assistance (like food, diapers, and childcare),


treatment navigation, access to prenatal and medical care, harm reduction education, and support navigating Children's Protective Services or the legal system.




